

IDCN publishes Annual Review 2015

Career network reached over 85 Corporate members in the past year

Vevey, July 6, 2016 – The International Dual Career Network can look back on a very successful year 2015: it launched two more networks in Brussels and Hong Kong and it now counts over 85 Corporate Members worldwide. IDCN is pleased that it could win companies such as Total, Danone, Syngenta, Mars, Solvay, Reckitt Benckiser, British American Tobacco and BNP Paribas as new global members. During 2015, 164 partners found a job with the support of IDCN, and 116 partners were involved as volunteers worldwide.

The network furthermore implemented a new tool: the Talent Management Platform gives Corporate Members access to the IDCN talent pool and in turn provides access to jobs at Corporate Members companies for the partners. The IDCN website, which has been launched in 2014, saw an increase in traffic by 4.5 times in just one year.

The past year also brought a change in leadership to IDCN: Founder Sue Johnson stepped down as President and was succeeded by Louise Barrelet. Under her lead, IDCN strives to continue its growth and expansion.

In the current year, IDCN is celebrating its 5th anniversary and will gain yet two more networks. Copenhagen, the first Scandinavian location, launched in April, and Singapore, launched in June.
